Equip individuals and families with resources to help them create in creating safe and secure living environments.

Emergency Food and Housing for Individuals and Families

Strategies:

- Provide services to children, individuals, and families in emergency shelters, including services provided to special populations.
- Programs that provide short to medium-term rental and utility assistance. Housing relocation and stabilization services to rapidly house families who meet the federal definition of homelessness.

Domestic Violence Support and Intervention

Strategies:

- Provide educational services targeted at children, individuals, and families to mitigate the risk of domestic violence and promote positive interactions and effective communication within the family unit, thereby reducing stress.
- Offer comprehensive services to support the recovery of individuals, children, and families affected by domestic violence. This may involve legal services, emergency financial assistance, and appropriate resource referrals.
